

Editing the Challenge

Instructions for Viewing Challenge Details on the DBR77 Platform

Navigate to the "Challenges" Tab

- **Select "Marketplace":** From the product menu on the DBR77 platform, select "Marketplace."
- **Access "Challenges":** Click on the "Challenges" tab and then select "All."



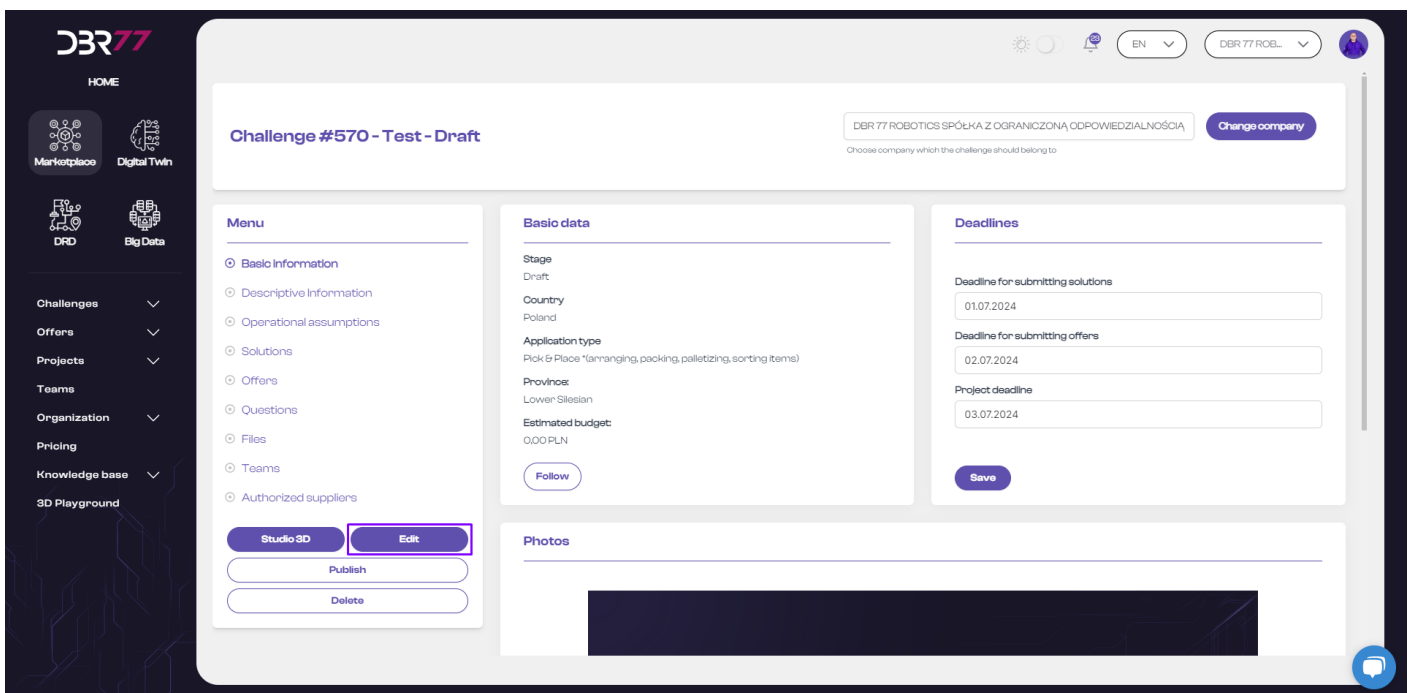
Access Challenge Details

- **Select Challenge Details:**
Locate the challenge you wish to view or edit. Published challenges are visible to all registered integrators on the platform or to a supplier list created by the investor.



Edit the Challenge

- **Click "Edit":**
Use the "Edit" button to update the challenge information.

Edit in 3D Studio

- **Before Publishing the Challenge:**

It is recommended to create a visualization of the area intended for automation and robotics. This allows integrators to suggest adjustments and represent the process post-implementation.

- To edit the visualization in 3D Studio, click the **"3D Studio"** button.
